Something is coming at that very moment. (Something is about to come)

It is considered present tense even though you say,

(people... animate) (something... inanimate)

qa kimashita/kita" (polite form) (friendly form)

•	 arrives (at that moment)
•	 coming (at that moment)

happened (at that moment)

For example: communication, a vehicle, event, animate object (person, animal, etc.)
